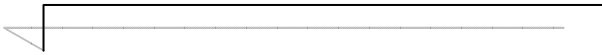

So far, we are 88 members, join us to reach the #100 in 2009, and you will receive a fancy fridge magnet !!

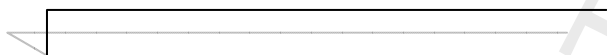

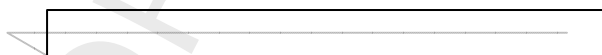
